As you are aware your son / daughter is taking part in the Dora Love project during Wednesday enrichment sessions this year. The project encourages young people to think about the issues surrounding the Holocaust and develop projects which investigate how it relates to the attitudes, discrimination and prejudices still around now. So the students can successfully take part in the project, we are running a trip to London to get inspiration and ideas for this year's theme 'Torn away from home'.

The coach will depart from Saxmundham Free School at 6.00am in the morning therefore students should arrive at school no later than 5.50am to be registered. In London we are planning to visit the Jewish Museum to view the holocaust galleries and a new exhibition on the Kinder Transport. We are also visiting the Museum of Migration which has just opened an exhibition titled 'Room to Breathe' which the staff have offered to show us around. We will be travelling around London using the Underground. We are aiming to return to Saxmundham Free School at 9:00pm. Please make arrangements to collect your son / daughter at this time (if the time of arrival changes students can update you via mobile phone).

In previous trips, we have been able on occasions, to arrange a drop off on the way back to school in the evenings at either Tesco Copdock or Martlesham for students living near Ipswich and Felixstowe. This cannot however be guaranteed as it is dependent on the driver being willing to do this and the strict rules on driving time that they have to follow. Due to the tight schedule in the morning all students will have to board the coach at Saxmundham Free School.

5:50 am	Students arrive at school
6:00 am	Coach departs
10:00 am	Arrive in London (Victoria Embankment)
10:15 am	Travel on London Underground to Camden
11:00 am	Visit Jewish Museum
1:30 pm	Lunch in Camden Market – students will be allowed to go off from the teacher in a small group to purchase their own lunch – all students will be given clear instructions on when and where to meet back and will be provided with a school mobile phone number so they can contact the teacher if needed.
2:30 pm	Travel on London Underground to Lambeth
3:00 pm	Visit Museum of Migration
4:45 pm	Walk back to Victoria Embankment
5:30 pm	Coach departs London (Victoria Embankment)
9:00 pm	Arrive back at school

Due to the long day, students will be served fruit juice and cereal bars on the journey to London. Students will need to bring some money with them so they can buy their own lunch in Camden Market. Students should bring food that they can eat on the coach on the return journey in the evening, this should be packed in a cool bag and can be kept on the coach whilst in London. Please note that due to Jewish Kashrut food law no meat can be taken into the Jewish Museum.

This trip is being offered at no cost as part of Saxmundham Free School's enrichment programme. However, students will need to bring money to purchase their own lunch and a donation for the Museum of Migration



which is offering our school a free visit in exchange for a donation (we suggest students bring with them a donation of between £2 and £5).
